### LAST MINUTE KIDS FLY FREE



If you want to take the kids to the spiritual home of Lego – Billund, Denmark – you can fly them there free from June 1. The BA deal is available for children aged 12 or under flying with a paying adult from Heathrow until October 31; it also includes flights to Belfast, Inverness, Leeds, Newcastle and Edinburgh ([ba.com/kids-fly-free](http://ba.com/kids-fly-free)). Returns to Billund start at £73. Book a family cabin at Legoland, Billund, from £313 a night, including park tickets ([legolandholidays.dk](http://legolandholidays.dk)).

### NEXT MONTH FIVE-STAR CYPRUS



Modelled on a traditional Cypriot village, complete with a Byzantine-style chapel, the luxury Anassa hotel, in the west of the island, has reopened after a multimillion-pound refurbishment. It has new-look rooms, new villas and a revamped spa – but provides the same old five-star service. Conduct a languid site inspection during a seven-night stay in a studio suite; from £1,700pp, B&B, including flights and private transfers, departing on June 3 ([scottdunn.com](http://scottdunn.com)).
